


HELLO

Through the decades, I've gained intimate knowledge of our region's high Andean dry forest, a rare ecosystem that covers just 1% of our nation. Shockingly, its intricate diversity remains largely unknown. From its endemic species to the adaptations these creatures have developed to thrive at 1400 meters altitude, there is so much to uncover. More critically, several species teeter on the brink of extinction.

ENTER SAVITA: A REFUGE FOR ENDANGERED WONDERS

To prevent the loss of these precious species, I've taken a heartfelt decision to purchase a 4500-meter plot of land right by the canyon of the Suarez River. Here, we aim to establish the 'Savita' wildlife refuge. Named after the term 'silver snake' in the language of the ancient Guanes tribe, it pays homage to the life-sustaining Suarez River.

At Savita, our vision spans:

- Conservation Efforts: We've begun reforesting the area with endemic species. Plans for a nursery are also underway. By creating organic fertilizers and joining hands with the local community and scientists, our mission is to understand, protect, and rejuvenate the high Andean forest's natural life.
- Education and Awareness: Savita will also be a hub for all age groups eager to delve into this ecosystem's secrets. Through a mix of educational, touristic, and social initiatives, we aim to foster greater appreciation and stewardship for our unique high Andean dry forest.
- Research Opportunities: Scientists and volunteers keen to document and safeguard this ecosystem's intricacies will find a welcoming platform at Savita.
